Traditional Music (14 or 17 weeks)

Music lessons are offered through the Traditional Music program where instruction in a specific instrument is taught in individual lessons on a one to one basis. These lessons are taught by the Bethel College music faculty and they may meet at the Bethel College campus in North Newton or at BCAPA.

After an instructor is assigned, the student and instructor arrange a weekly lesson time and whether they will meet for a 14 or 17 week semester. Students will perform in periodic recitals set by the instructor. **All students must officially register through BCAPA to before lessons will be taught.**

The semesters run for 14 through 17 weeks and are determined by the student and the instructor and can be 30, 45 or 60 minute lessons.

Lessons are available with apprentice instructors, faculty recommended music education majors. These sessions are 30 minutes and meet for 14 weeks at a time.

Lessons offered: Piano, Violin, Viola, Cello, Guitar, Organ, Flute, Saxophone, Percussion & Voice.

Music Performance Ensembles:

Students may register to join the **Guitar Ensemble under the Direction of Howard Glanton** or our new **Cello Ensemble under the Direction of Parker Stanley**. These ensembles meet weekly. Days and times TBA.

Individual Lessons

The Suzuki philosophy involves a special partnership among student, parent and teacher using the techniques of listening, practicing, and performing. Suzuki lessons are offered for violin and viola for students of all ages and levels of skill. All Suzuki lessons are taught at the Academy. Lesson times are determined by the instructor and student.

Part of Suzuki training is performance. At BCAPA we understand that not all students wish to perform, however we also know that performing with support and positive encouragement strengthens skills and confidence. We strive to provide such an environment and offer multiple performance opportunities. Multiple performance opportunities will be made available to the students including Book Recitals, Solo Recitals, and group performances and many events such as Fall Fest and the Academy's Spring Concert.

Individual lessons meet for 30, 45, and 60 minutes for a 17 week semester.

Suzuki Groups and Orchestras (17 weeks)

In addition to the weekly private lessons there are group classes that involve repertoire, theory and chamber music. Group Classes provide peer interaction which is crucial for learning the musical language. As students participate in the groups and orchestras, they will gain additional lessons in music theory. Consult the Program Director for specific times and days.

All students must officially register for their lessons and/or classes before attending them by filling out a registration form. Registration is for the length of the semester, not on a month by month basis. Tuition payments may be made monthly or for the full semester.

Withdrawal - A 30-day written notice is required for early withdrawal from music lessons and dance classes.

Missed classes -If a group class is missed by the student, payment is still required to remain in the class. If an individual music lesson is missed by the student, it is at the instructor's discretion whether to reschedule or not. If a dance class is missed, please discuss with your instructor for make up opportunities.

Pricing... All monthly payments are due by the 1st of each month. If paying for the full semester, payment is due by the second month unless arranged otherwise with the Director of the Academy. If payment due dates are not met, there will be an additional \$10 late fee. If tuition is late more than one month, and payment arrangements have not been made with the Director, lessons will be suspended until the payment is made. A schedule of payment amounts and due dates will be given at the beginning of the semester. There is a \$12.50 registration fee for families who are new to BCAPA's lessons/classes this spring. This fee does not apply to families who paid the \$25 registration fee last fall semester. Tuition scholarships are available based on financial need.

Tuition payment can be made for the whole semester at the beginning or in four monthly installments throughout the term. After a 10 day grace period a \$10 late fee will be charged. If an account is over a month past due. The student may be suspended from lessons or classes until payment or arrangements have been made.

If tuition is paid monthly, the installments are due:

1st installment is due by the first class or lesson (covers end of January through February)

2nd, 3rd, & 4th installments are due by the 1st of the month. Late fees will be charged on the 11th of the month.

It is assumed that the student will receive all lessons in that semester so the monthly tuition charge remains the same amount regardless of missed lessons by the student. Please speak with instructor about setting up make-up lessons if needed.
