

Athletic Training Education Program

HEALTH GUIDELINES

1. Students must have a current Physical Examination (see attached health exam form or Bethel/ Hesston College Athletic Participation Physical).
2. The nature of athletic training puts the student and patient at risk for transmission of disease; therefore, students should have current immunizations and provide a record of them.
3. Students with any of, but not limited to, the following illnesses may not participate in Clinical or Field Experiences:
 - i. Elevated temperature > 100° F orally
 - ii. Acute febrile upper respiratory infection, Including Group A Streptococcal
 - iii. Influenza
 - iv. Acute Diarrhea
 - v. Herpes simplex
 - vi. Chickenpox, Pertussis, Measles, Mumps, Rubella
 - vii. Draining abscesses, boils, impetigo
 - viii. Acute viral Hepatitis
 - ix. Pulmonary Tuberculosis
 - x. Scabies
3. A statement of release from a Health Care Examiner may be necessary before returning to the clinical or field experiences following diagnosis/treatment that affects student/patient health.
