

Transfer Advising for Bethel College Nursing Program

Students interested in transferring to Bethel College to complete the Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree are advised to use associate of arts general education requirements as a guide. Some generalizations are given below:

Nursing requirements:

- Minimum 2.75 grade point average
- All supporting courses for the nursing program must be completed with a C or better.
 - Anatomy and Physiology (4-6 hours)
 - Cell Biology and Microbes (or Microbiology) (4-5 hours)
 - Introductory Chemistry (3-5 hours)
 - Principles of Nutrition (3 hours)
 - Applied Statistics (3-4 hours)
 - General Psychology (3 hours)
 - Pathophysiology (3 hours)
 - Lifespan Development (or Human Growth and Development or Developmental Psychology) (3 hours)
 - Introduction to Sociology (3 hours)
 - English Composition II (or Critical Writing) (3 hours)
 - Public Speaking (3 hours)
 - Pharmacology (3 hours)

Arts and Humanities

6 credit hours selected from the following, in at least two different disciplines:

- Literature
- Art Appreciation or Art History
- Intro to Philosophy
- Music Appreciation
- Theater Arts

Social Sciences

6 credit hours selected from two different disciplines. Is met when prerequisites are met.

Required courses:

- General Psychology
- Introduction to Sociology

Science and Math

6 credit hours selected from two different disciplines. Is met when prerequisites are met.

Required courses:

- Cell Biology and Microbes
- Introduction to Chemistry

Competencies/Skills

- Writing competency: C or better in English Composition II
- Oral competency: C or better in Public Speaking
- Mathematics competency: C or better in Intermediate Algebra or College Algebra

Other requirements:

- Enter Bethel College with at least 64 credit hours, exclusive of nursing courses.
- ESL, remedial and vocational courses are not accepted in transfer.
- Once admitted, student will need to accrue a minimum of 60 baccalaureate hours.
