

Rodolphe Petter Cheyenne ledger drawings

Rodolphe Petter was a General Conference Mennonite missionary to the Cheyenne in Oklahoma (1891-1916) and Montana (1916-1947). These ledger drawings come from his papers here at the Mennonite Library and Archives.

Unfortunately there is little information accompanying these drawings in the Petter papers. The artist or artists and the circumstances of composition are so far unknown, except for the last item, which is not a ledger drawing.

The numbering system used here, and also the use of 'a' and 'b' to denote the front and back sides of each sheet, is completely arbitrary. We simply numbered the sheets as we found them in the folder while scanning.

There are a total of 36 sheets.

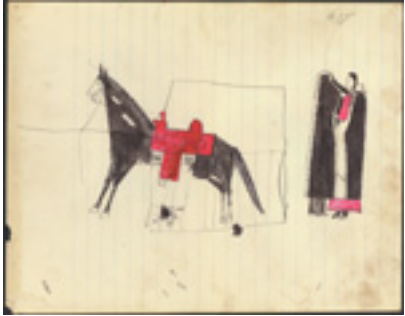

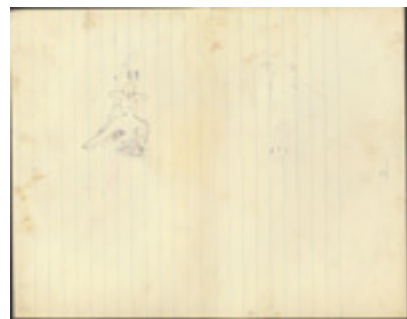
