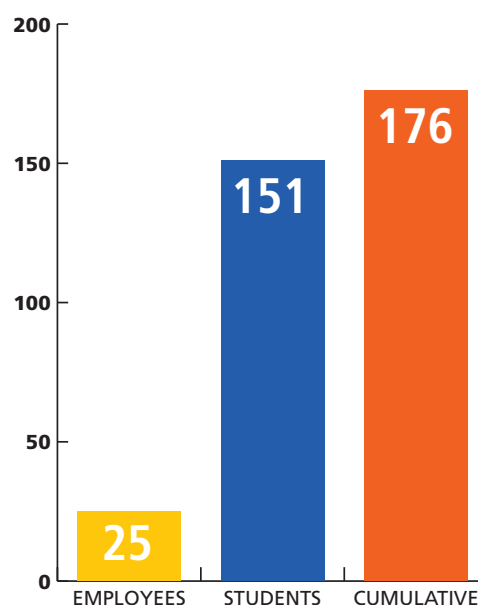

Bethel College is committed to data transparency by reporting weekly updates on the number of positive COVID-19 cases among students and employees on campus. The dashboard below details the medically confirmed COVID-19 cases among faculty, staff and students in or around the Bethel College campus community. The College is making COVID-19 data available for public review to share campus health trends, while also protecting patient privacy.

To respect the privacy of our students and employees and to follow federal privacy law, Bethel College will not release specific information about individuals who have tested positive.

An active case is an individual in isolation following a positive test result. Student cases and employee cases illustrate the breakdown of positive cases between the two groups. Cumulative cases represent the total positive cases since July 31, 2020. As an individual's isolation period ends, they will be removed from the active cases and placed in the appropriate case category. When an individual leaves isolation their case is still reflected in the cumulative total.

Every effort is being made to keep accurate counts of those reported.

The dashboard will be revised Friday afternoons.
